PITTSFIELD GIRLS STORMS PAST EASTLONGMEADOW IN 69-34 WIN

AMHERST, MASS. -- The Pittsfield Generals completed a statement 69-34 win against the Eastlongmeadow Spartans.

The Generals were led by Harolyn Castillo garnering 16 points, grabbing seven rebounds and two assists. Caprese Conyers recorded 16 points on the evening going 7-13 from the field goal with five rebounds and three assists.

The Spartans were led by Emma Gosselyn with a team high 10 points going 5-6 from the field goal.

Breaking Down The Action

- Pittsfield opened the game with an early 8-0 run over two minutes keyed by a three pointer from Harolyn Castillo.
- Emma Gosselyn started the scoring for East Longmeadow with a fastbreak layup with 3:10 left in the quarter.
- Asia Smith-Moody found Castillo under the basket to extend the Generals lead, 13-2.
- With less than a minute in the quarter, Caroline Sherman found the net to give Pittsfield a 15-2 advantage going into the second quarter.
- Grace Stetz' layup started the scoring just 14 seconds into the second quarter.
- Gosselyn broke a scoring drought with back-to back layups to cut the Spartans deficit to 19-6 with 5:55 left in the half.
- The two teams traded baskets highlighted by a transition layup from Caprese Conyers with the Generals taking a 27-10 lead into halftime.
- Pittsfield started the second half with a 8-0 run over two minutes highlighted with a euro step from Conyers to extend the General's lead, 35-10.
- A few shots from the charity stripe broke a near two minute scoring drought for Pittsfield.
- Grace Blais transition layup gave the Spartans their 12th point of the afternoon with 2:50 left in the quarter.
- A 5-0 run powered by Blais cut the Pittsfield lead but a Roos Bajnath layup before the buzzer gave the team Generals a 47-19 lead.
- Bre'jai Ellerbee fought through traffic on the baseline to open the fourth with 7:37 left in the game.
- East Longmeadow's M. Knowles brought the score to 50-21 with a midrange jumper.
- The Sparatans engineered a 6-0 run highlighted by a three-point play from Kendall Reid.
- With a little over a minute left, Conyers stole the ball at the top of the key for a fastbreak layup.
- The Generals capped the second half with a layup from Bajnath for a final score of 69-34.
