NORTHAMPTON GIRLS DOMINATES AMHERST IN FIRST GAME OF PVTO

AMHERST, MASS. -- The Northampton Blue Devils dominated the Amherst Hurricanes, 75-10 in the first game of the 2024 Pioneer Valley Tip Off. Northampton held Amherst controlled the game from the start holding the Hurricanes to single digits throughout the game.

- Off a rebound, Liv Joenson found the basket under the net.
- A high arc three for Makayla Fydenkevez made the score 20-2.
- After nearly seven minutes without a basket, Maeve Fitzgerald's basket before the buzzer made it 24-4 after the first quarter.
- Heafey's layup started the second quarter with 7:11 left on the clock.
- Yairelis Blanchard answered quickly with a field goal to make the score 26-6.
- Amherst's early foul trouble got the best of them with Heafey making 2-of-3 free throws.
- Emme Calkins' layup extended the blue devils lead 32-6 with 5:02 left in the half.
- A 14-0 run hightlighted with a three-point play by Fydenkevez extended the Blue Devils lead to 45-6 into halftime.
- Calkins' layup 28 seconds into the third period made the score 47-6.
- Northampton's shots continued to drop with a fastbreak layup by Anna Oravec extending their lead.
- The blue devils momentum continued ending the third period with a score of 61-6.
- The Hurricanes broke an over 10 minute scoring drought with a pair of free throws by Blanchard to make the score 61-8 with 7:14 left in the game.
- Northampton answered quickly with back to back shots of their own by Joenson and Fydenkevez.
- Hatteras Lewis connected on a jumper beneath the net to extend the lead, 67-8.
- Amherst's Hall sank a field goal with less than a minute in the game to make the score 72-8.
- The Blue Devils cemented their lead with a shot from behind the arc to finish the game 75-10.
