

AGAWAM GIRLS SECURES COMEBACK WIN AGAINST WEST SPRINGFIELD

AMHERST, MASS. -- The Agawam Brownies girls team took a comeback win against the West Springfield Terriers girls team on Saturday evening in game three of the Pioneer Valley Tip Off.

The Brownies were led by Mia Canavan recording a double-double with a game high 23 points and grabbing 10 rebounds. The senior tacked on two steals and a block.

The Terriers were led by Darby Poe with a team high 14 points going 6-18 from the field goal and nabbing nine rebounds.

Breaking Down The Action

- The Brownies opened the scoring with a jump shot under the basket by Mia Canavan with 7:46 left in the quarter.
- The Terriers responded by taking the lead with a midrange shot from Morgan Peabody and another by Darby Poe.
- Agawam garnered a 10-0 run highlighted by a triple from Marlee Montagna to extend their lead to 12-4 going into the second period.
- The Brownies broke the near four minute scoring drought with a fastbreak layup by Isabella Laprise with 4:12 left in the half for a score of 14-4.
- Amelia Kisiel cut the Terrier deficit down to six with a three point play.
- Kisiel found the net with a jumper under the basket to bring the score to 14-10 at the half.
- The Brownies opened the half with a shot from behind the arc just nine seconds into the half by Poe to put them within one.
- West Springfield took the lead with a midrange jumper off the backboard by Poe.
- Agawam retook their lead quickly with shots from Montagna and Canavan.
- The Terriers took a one point lead keyed by two shots under the basket by Kisiel with 5:00 in the third for a score of 19-18.
- A basket by West Springfield's Kylie extended their lead, 21-18.
- The two teams traded baskets with the Brownies tying the game at 26-26 off shots from the charity stripe by Canavan going into the fourth quarter.
- Agawam broke the tie with a triple from Laprise with 6:25 left in the game.
- Canavan extended the Brownies lead to 31-26 with a shot under the basket.
- Kelsey Turner cut the West Springfield deficit with a layup off an inbound pass.
- The teams traded shots with the Brownies lead extending to 35-31 with help from free throws with less than four minutes left in the game.
- A shot from downtown by Poe put West Springfield within one but was recovered by Agawam's Emma LaCresse.
- With less than two minutes to go, both teams exchanged baskets with the Brownies garnering a 9-2 run with 43 seconds on the clock for a score of 44-40.
- Capped by a shot from the charity stripe, Agawam held onto their lead for a final score of 49-40.
