

AMHERST, Mass. – The Chicopee Comp Colts boys dominated the Chicopee Pacer boys in an 86-49 victory for game two of the Pioneer Valley Tip-Off.

The Colts were led by Brody Fay who scored 23 points going 9-for-15 from the field with a trio of three pointers. The Senior grabbed nine rebounds and recorded a pair of assists.

The Pacers were led by Jabari Flowers with 16 points going 7-for-11 from the field with three boards.

Breaking Down the Action

- Chicopee Comp opened the scoring with a 6-0 run over a minute highlighted by a three-point play from #3.
- Chicopee answered with a layup from #1 for their first points of the night.
- Jacoby Haney keyed another 6-0 run for the Colts with 5:32 left in the first quarter.
- Back-to-back layups from Jabari Flowers snapped a Pacers scoring drought for an 18-6 scoreboard.
- After a 6-2 run for Chicopee, the Colts took 20-12 lead into the second quarter.
- A dunk from Elijah Kleps opened the scoring for the second quarter less
- Francisco Nieves drilled a triple to cut the Pacers deficit to eight.
- Fay's four points keyed a 7-0 run for the Colts with 2:45 on the clock.
- Alex Mangual's jumper cut the Pacers deficit, 46-28 into the halftime.
- Coby Paul's free throws snapped a nearly two-minute scoring drought for both teams.
- The teams matched baskets with a jumper from Kleps extending the Colts lead, 55-33 with 3:05 left in the third.
- In 90 second, Chicopee outscored the Colts 8-2 but was answered quickly by Haney's basket from the arc.
- Haney's layup gave the Chicopee Comp a 62-45 advantage into the fourth.
- Five points from Modesto Gonzalez highlighted a 7-0 run over 90 seconds for the Colts.
- Nieves gave the Pacers their first points of the half with over five minutes to play.
- The Colts engineered an 8-0 scoring run for a 77-47 lead.
- Mario Lavertue's jumper capped a 9-2 scoring run to give Chicopee Comp an 86-49 victory.
