

Chicopee Pacers take 48-25 win against Chicopee Comp

AMHERST, Mass. – The Chicopee Pacers girls dominated the Chicopee Comp colts girls 48-25 to close out day one of the Pioneer Valley Tip-Off.

The Pacers were led by Sophia Moreira with 13 points, two rebounds and an assist.

The Colts were led by Sheyenne Santiago with eight points, 10 rebounds and an assist.

Breaking Down the Action

- Trinity McCarthy opened the scoring for Chicopee comp with a freethrow with six minutes left in the first quarter.
- Kiyah Price tabbed six straight points to give The Pacers a 6-1 lead.
- Price found Sophia Moreira under the basket with three minutes left in the first.
- Walieris Pena's pair from the charity stripe for a 10-3 scoreboard.
- A putback layup from Nylah Francis capped the first quarter with the Colts holding a 13-3 lead.
- Giselle Rivera tabbed a triple, but McCarthy answered with one for the Pacers.
- With the help of the charity stripe, Sheyenne Shantiago and Pena combined for four points to pull Chicopee Comp within six.
- A jumper from Santiago sent both teams to the halftime break with Chicopee holding an 18-12 lead.
- Santiago's layup cut the Colts deficit to four with seven minutes in the third.
- Price keyed an 11-1 run over three minutes to extend the Pacer lead, 29-15.
- Two baskets from the charity stripe pulled Chicopee Comp within 12 with 2:17 left in the third.
- Cassidy Pytel's fastbreak layup closed out the third with the Colts holding a 31-17 advantage.
- The teams exchanged baskets with a shot from the arc by Nylah Francis extending the Pacers lead, 38-21 with 3:34 left in the game.
- In an attempt to comeback, the Colts fired from the charity stripe but were unable to gain momentum. The Pacers took a 48-25 win to open their season.
