

FRONTIER RED HAWKS BOYS PULL OUT VICTORY AGAINST EAST HAMPTON

AMHERST, MASS. – The Frontier Red Hawks boys team squeezed out a 60-58 win against the East Hampton Eagles.

The Red Hawks were led by Max Millette recording a double-double before halftime. The junior scored a game high 28 points, grabbing 18 rebounds, and tacking on six assists.

The Eagles were led by Logan Boyle scoring 15 points, going 4-5 from the free throw line and nabbing five rebounds.

Breaking Down The Action

- Frontier took an early 3-0 lead 20 seconds into the game with a triple from Rowan Modestow but was quickly answered with a three from East Hampton's Brayden English.
- After trading baskets early on, Frontier garnered an 11-7 lead capped by a midrange jumper by Max Millette with 4:40 on the clock.
- The Eagles garnered a 5-1 run to tie the game but a putback layup by Millette put the Red Hawks on top.
- With the help of the charity stripe, East Hampton tied the game with 1:59 left in the first quarter.
- Before the end of the quarter, both teams traded baskets with East Hampton taking a 19-17 advantage into the second off a shot from behind the arc by Patrick Larson.
- Diego Frazier found Millette under the basket with 6:24 on the clock to tie the game but the Eagles' Jasper Alvarez retook the lead with a three.
- Despite falling behind, the Red Hawks found their momentum with a 6-2 run capped by a tap in putback from Millette to give Frontier the lead with 2:47 left in the half.
- The teams went basket for basket and exchanged the lead with Frontier's Ty Skroski putting the Red Hawks ahead, 32-30 going into halftime.
- Frontier's momentum continued in the third outscoring East Hampton, 6-1 highlighted with a breakaway layup by Millette.
- The Eagles got some help off free throws and a putback layup from Jaxon Spearance gave East Hampton a 39-38 lead with 2:21 left in the third.
- A 7-2 run before the end of the third gave the Red Hawks a 45-41 lead.
- Austin Durso's layup and a triple by Frazier extended the Red Hawks lead, 50-41 with 6:31 left to play.
- The teams shared baskets highlighted by a with a three-point play by East Hampton's Logan Boyle to put the Eagles within one.
- Garret Dredge drained a deep three with 2:32 left in the game extended the Red Hawks lead, 58-54 but a driving layup by Boyle put East Hampton within two.
- Each team scored a couple shots from the charity stripe but Frontier was able to hold on and take a 60-58 win.
